A variety of ride services are available to any York County resident needing assistance getting to cancer care at area facilities, including, but not limited to:

- Southern Maine Health Care
- York Hospital

Types of Rides:

Bus/Van

Regularly scheduled routes operate throughout the York County area.

Volunteer Drivers

Operate their own vehicles, have passed rigorous screening, received training, and have a photo ID badge for identification.

NOTE: We cannot guarantee a ride for every trip requested, but we will make every effort to meet your transportation needs.

What to do?

1. Call us at 207 324-5762 or come in to our office in Sanford:

2. Sign up for your ride, which may be done over the phone. We will need:
 - Your basic information,
 - Your appointment date,
 - Your appointment time,
 - Your appointment location, and
 - How long you expect to be there.
